




## 科主任後記


Dear Mr Mo,

Hong Kong has many problems with its housing. Citizens are frustrated with the price of houses. House prices are high because of the short supply of available land for building. Demand is greater than supply which makes prices very expensive. Hong Kong salaries are often too low to buy a place to live in especially for young people.
